- Facilitated modelers in-person meeting to discuss Project Team feedback, development of draft management strategy and MSE operating model

Modelers Tasks

- (1) Revise the operating model (abalone dynamics and fishery dynamics) portion of the Management Strategy Evaluation (MSE) detailed in the TNC-led collaborative proposal to address peer review recommendations including the incorporation of low density dynamics and varying environmental conditions, and to conduct subsequent sensitivity runs. Share any high level thinking on the operating model or potential scenarios with the Project Team for the September meeting.
- (2) Revise the proposed management strategy in line with Project Team feedback, and present at the next Project Team meeting in September 2019 for vetting.
- (3) Test refined management strategies through MSE and present preliminary MSE results to the Project Team by the October meeting.
