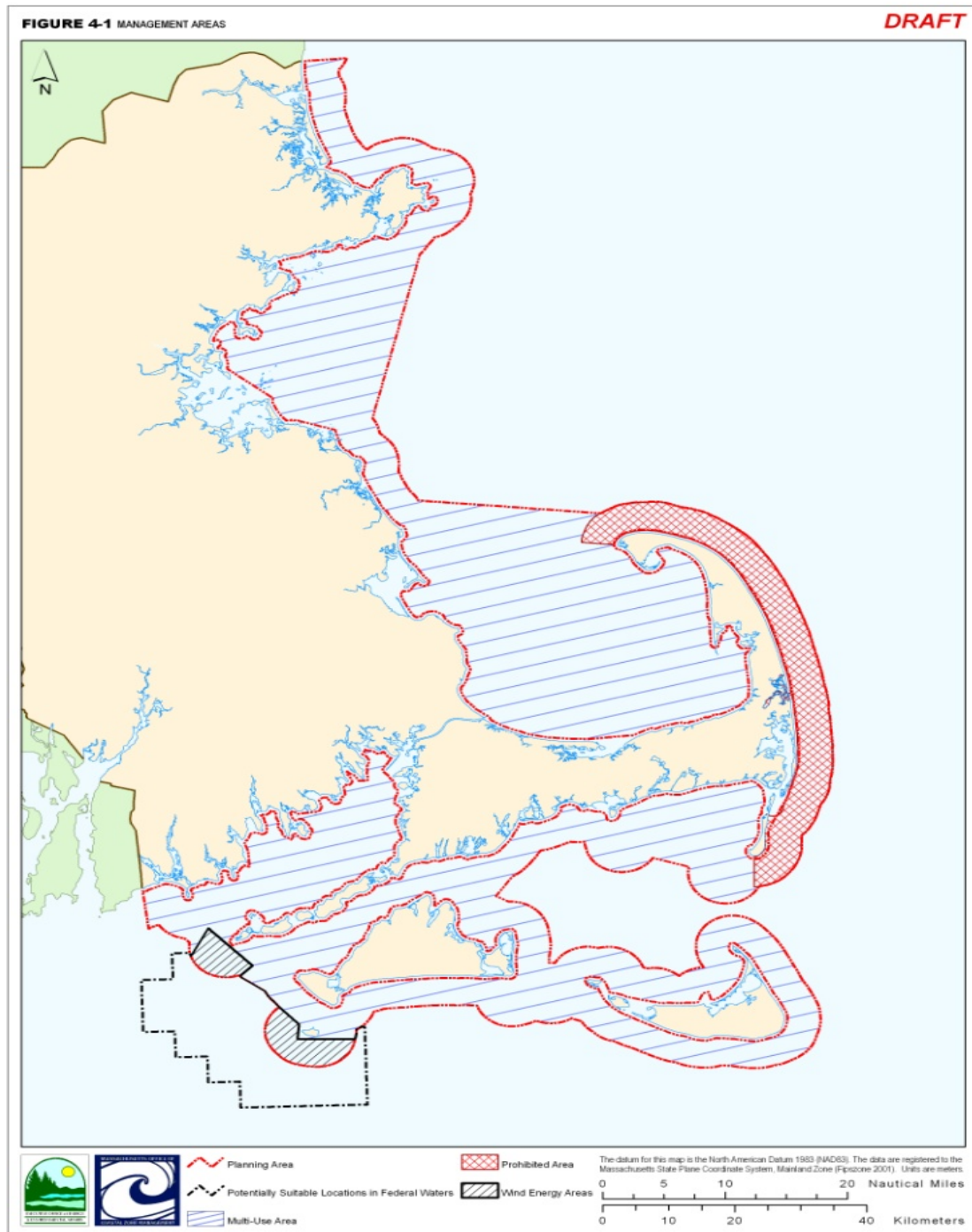

An example of marine planning areas, from the Massachusetts Ocean Management Plan, released in draft form earlier this summer and expected to be finalized by the end of this year. The Plan is intended to provide “comprehensive science-based planning... to assure long-term protection and sustainable use of ocean resources.” The Plan designates separate management areas for environmental protection and human uses, with 13% of Massachusetts waters set aside as conservation areas, 2% for renewable energy development, and the remaining area for mixed human uses.
