PROJECT LOCATION: Four alley segments: 1) alley running east-west and north-south between 32nd Street and 33rd Street from Central Avenue to Wadsworth Avenue; 2) alley running east-west and north-south, between 33rd Street and 34th Street from Central Avenue to Wadsworth Avenue; 3) alley running east-west and north-south, just west of Wadworth Avenue and north of Jefferson Boulevard; and 4) alley running east-west between 33rd Street and Jefferson Boulevard from Griffith Avenue to a supermarket parking lot at the western terminus. DESCRIPTION OF NATURE, PURPOSE, AND BENEFICIARIES OF PROJECT: The project proposes to install green stormwater infrastructure in the alleys to capture, infiltrate, and retain stormwater runoff. Components include integral curb and gutter; concrete walks; concrete pavement; interlocking permeable pavers; bump-out planters that perform traffic calming and rainwater garden functions; vine planter along the edge of the alley with vines planted adjacent to walls/fences within the alley; catch basins; drywells; monitoring wells; and pedestrian-enhancements like murals, public sculptures, seating, trash cans, pet waste stations, lighting and a porous rubber walking loop. Existing access points currently oriented toward the alley (i.e. vehicle and pedestrian gates) will remain in place. The project will take place within existing public right of way.
