### EXEMPT FROM RECORDING FEES -- GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 6103

### AGREEMENT PROTECTING THE PUBLIC INTEREST IN CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS AND DEVELOPMENT (Public Resources Code § 31116(c))

This agreement is entered into by the California State Coastal Conservancy ("the Conservancy") the City of Eureka ("the landowner"), and the Redwood Community Action Agency ("the nonprofit organization").

The purpose of this agreement is to protect the public interest in construction and development accomplished with Conservancy funds, as required by California Public Resources Code § 31116(c).

#### PERTINENT FACTS

- A. California Public Resources Code §§ 31116 authorizes the Conservancy to award grants to nonprofit organizations for the purposes of Division 21 of the Public Resources Code.
- B. The landowner and the nonprofit organization are California nonprofit organizations exempt from taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the United States Internal Revenue Code and whose purposes are consistent with Division 21.
- C. The landowner owns certain real property ("the property"), located partially in the coastal zone in Humboldt County, California, corresponding to Humboldt County Assessor's Parcel Number 301-031-008, and described in Exhibit A, which is incorporated by reference and attached.
- D. On June 15, 2017, the Conservancy authorized a grant to the nonprofit organization, subsequently awarded under Grant Agreement No. 17-001 to enhance approximately 7,200 feet of Martin Slough and its tributaries, starting at the tide gates at the confluence of Martin Slough and Swain Slough and extending upstream onto the Eureka Municipal Golf Course property. The project includes enhancement of associated wetlands and riparian habitat, with the objectives of enhancing plant, fish, and wildlife habitat, improving water quality, increasing resiliency to climate change, and reducing flooding. The Eureka Municipal Golf Course part of the project involves the restoration of off-channel pond and riparian habitat, brackish marsh,

and the Martin Slough channel in the property owned by the City of Eureka at the upstream end of the project in the County of Humboldt.

- E. Public Resources Code § 31116(c) requires that the Conservancy execute an agreement sufficient to protect the public interest in any improvements or development constructed under its grant; this agreement must be recorded in the county in which the real property is located.
- F. The grant referred to above was conditioned on the nonprofit organization, the landowner, and the Conservancy executing and recording an agreement to protect the public interest in all improvements or developments constructed with Conservancy funds, as required by Public Resources Code § 31116(c).

THE LANDOWNER, THE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION, AND THE CONSERVANCY AGREE AS FOLLOWS, in order to carry out the purposes of Public Resources Code § 31116(c), and in light of the Pertinent Facts, above:

- 1. **<u>DURATION</u>**. The term of this agreement shall be from the date last signed by a party below, through the reasonable lifetime of the improvements made with Conservancy funds, but in no event less than twenty years from commencement.
- 2. MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION. During the term of this agreement, the landowner and the nonprofit organization shall maintain and operate the property and the improvements made with Conservancy funds and shall use the property and improvements in a manner consistent with the purposes of the Conservancy's grant to the nonprofit organization, which include the enhancement of wetland and aquatic habitat on the property.
- 3. <u>IMPLEMENTATION</u>. The nonprofit organization shall implement site improvements on the property in accordance with Grant Agreement No. 17-001, including, without limitation, excavating channel and wetland features and enhancing riparian habitat along Martin Slough with the objectives of enhancing plant, fish, and wildlife habitat, improving water quality, increasing resiliency to climate change, and reducing flooding.
- 4. <u>SUCCESSORS TO THE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION</u>. If, for any reason, including, but not limited to the dissolution and winding up of the nonprofit organization, the nonprofit organization is unwilling or unable to meet its obligations under this agreement, the Executive Officer of the Conservancy shall have the right to designate a public entity or nonprofit corporation to assume the responsibilities of the nonprofit organization under this agreement.
- 5. <u>SUCCESSORS IN INTEREST</u>. The terms of this agreement shall be binding on all successors and assigns of the parties to this agreement.
- 6. **FORBEARANCE NOT A WAIVER**. Any forbearance on the part of the Conservancy, or its successor in interest, to enforce the terms and provisions of this agreement in the event of a

breach shall not be deemed a waiver of the Conservancy's right regarding any subsequent violation or breach.

- 7. **SEVERABILITY**. If any of the provisions of this agreement are found by a court of law to be of no force or effect, the validity of all other provisions shall be unaffected.

- 9. **RECORDATION**. This agreement shall be recorded in the official records of the County of Humboldt.
