



2021 Gear Retrieval Program: By The Numbers


- Retrieval Permits Issued: 6

- 244 Retrieved Traps by RAMP Zone:

 - Zone 2: 1 trap
 - Zone 3: 221 traps
 - Zone 4: 8 traps
- Dungeness Crab Vessels w/Retrieved Traps: 66
- Average Number of traps per Dungeness Crab Vessel: 3.7
- CDFW Reimbursements Issued: 14

2021 CDFW Gear Retrieval – Voluntary Efforts Outside of Program

- Section 132.2, Title 14, CCR allows recovery of lost or abandoned commercial Dungeness crab gear
- Up to 6 trap at any time
- Unlimited number between July 16- Oct 31
- Compensation not guaranteed
- No logbook requirement to account for annual totals
- 2021: reports of 6 traps recovered near Trinidad
