Emergency Recreational Hoop Net Regulations

- Fish and Game Commission Adopted Emergency
 Oct 13, 2022
- Effective date prior to start of recreational Dungeness crab season Nov 5, 2022

Emergency Hoop Net Proposed Regulations

- Clarify statewide 2-hour service interval
- Update hoop net definition
- Extend surface buoy marker requirement statewide
